INTRODUCTION

Syllabus of educational component “Fundamentals of Law” was compiled in accordance with the Standard of Higher Education of Ukraine and the educational and professional program "Nursing" as a part of training program of students of higher education at the first (bachelor's) level of education in the field of knowledge 22 "Health Care" specialty 223 "Nursing".

Description of educational component (annotation). The educational component “Fundamentals of Law” (further — EC) aimed at forming the legal worldview of future specialists in the field of medicine with a focus on nursing, creating a system of legal ideas, beliefs and skills of lawful behavior in professional medical activity, enriching theoretical ideas about the concepts and categories used by legal science. EC aims not only to provide the necessary knowledge, but also to teach the correct use of legal norms when performing relevant roles in society - both in professional medical activity and in society and personal life. After all, today one of the most important problems in the legal field is the low level of legal culture, which leads to negative consequences in our society. That is why, especially in modern conditions, the study of the given subject by students of higher education acquires special importance, it contributes to the mastery of general civilization values, the formation of the necessary level of legal and political culture, the development of electoral skills, mastery of the mechanisms of conscious self-realization in legal and political life, and familiarization with the basics of legal relations "medical worker - patient", "medical worker – government", "medical institution - patient", "medical institution – government".

The subject of study of the educational component is the fundamentals of law.

Interdisciplinary connections: EC “Fundamentals of Law” is a necessary component of the formation of the personality of a medical worker in a higher medical school. The study of the educational component is connected with the knowledge of such social-humanitarian and natural-scientific educational components - the history and culture of Ukraine; foundations of philosophical knowledge; life safety and the basics of bioethics; basics of nursing; nursing ethics and deontology; pharmacology and medical prescription; medical and social rehabilitation; economics of healthcare; marketing of medical services; management and leadership in nursing).

Prerequisites. Studying the EC "Fundamentals of Law" requires prior mastery of the following educational components: "History and Culture of Ukraine", " Ethics and Deontology of Nursing", “Philosophy”, “Basic of Nursing”, “Basic of Healthcare Organization” etc.

Post-requisites. The main provisions of the EC "Fundamentals of Law" must be applied when studying related educational components, and for obtaining the first (bachelor's) level of higher education / the sixth qualification level of the National Qualifications Framework.

1. THE PURPOSE AND TASKS OF THE EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT

1.1. The purpose of studying EC is in obtaining knowledge, skills and competencies to form a citizen's legal worldview, creating a system of legal ideas, beliefs and skills of lawful behavior in society. The course covers such important issues as law and order, delinquency and legal responsibility, legal discipline and legal culture. The course traces the history of Ukrainian statehood, considers the problems of building a democratic state governed by the rule of law in Ukraine, reveals the basics of certain branches of Ukrainian law and the most important regulations, the content of the Constitution of Ukraine, its key provisions for consolidating the state and social order of Ukraine. In this regard, the study of jurisprudence contributes to the formation of the necessary level of legal culture both in everyday life and in the relationship in medicine. The EC “Fundamentals of Law” taking about systematic review of the theory of law and the state, acquaintance with key provisions of the main branches of law, study of fundamental provisions of the Constitution of Ukraine, content of basic legal documents of Ukraine, problems and prospects of the legal system of Ukraine in connection with European integration processes and human rights.

1.2. The general tasks of studying the EC:

- development of electoral behavior skills;
- enrichment of theoretical ideas about concepts and categories used by legal science;
- learn to correctly use legal norms when performing appropriate roles in society - both in the following professional activity and in personal life;
- mastering of general civilizational values;
- creation of a system of legal concepts and beliefs of lawful behavior;
- formation of the necessary level of legal and political culture;
- formation of the legal outlook of future specialists.

1.3. Competences and learning outcomes the formation of which is facilitated by the educational component:

1.3.1. The study of the educational component ensures that students of higher education master the following **competencies**:

Types of control:

Current: oral discussion, written control of theoretical knowledge according to options, presentation of work results in small groups.

Intermediate: protection of the results of an individual task.

Additional: public presentation of a scientific product (theses, article...).

Final: credit.

3. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

3.1 The evaluation of the success of higher education applicants is carried out on the basis of the current "Instructions for the evaluation of educational activities under the ECTS for the organization of the educational process" (order of the Rector of KhNMU № 181 dated 21.08.2021).

The current educational activity (PND) of higher education students is monitored by the teacher of the academic group, after they have mastered each topic of the educational component, and grades are given using the 4-point (national) system. For applicants of higher education in the correspondence form of education, the current grades also include the grade for the completed individual task. At the end of the semester, the average grade (to the nearest hundredth) for the PND is automatically obtained by the teacher using the electronic journal of the ACU system. The final grade for the PND in the semester is defined as the arithmetic average of the national grades for each subject and P&P, rounded to 2 decimal places. The sum of points for the PND also includes the assessment for the completed individual work. Recalculation of the average grade for PND into a multi-point scale, for educational components that end with credit (Table 1).

The type of final control of the degree of mastery of the content of the educational component is the assessment, which is conducted by the teacher of the academic group according to the schedule (at the last class). For educational components, the study of which ends in the one semester, and the type of control is "credit", it is assumed that the overall evaluation of the component is taken into account.

Points are calculated as average arithmetic grades for all semesters of studying the discipline (to the nearest hundredth) according to table 1, automatically within the functional electronic journal of the ACU. After that it is recalculated on a multi-point scale according to Table 2 from 120 to 200 points and marked as "credited" or "not credited".
